Inserting *unitedstreaming* video segments into Notebook 9.5 Software

Inserting Video in Notebook 9.5

1. Identify digital video(s) from unitedstreaming and download to local computer.
2. Notebook 9.5 allows users to embed video as links within pages that will allow the video to play when clicked.

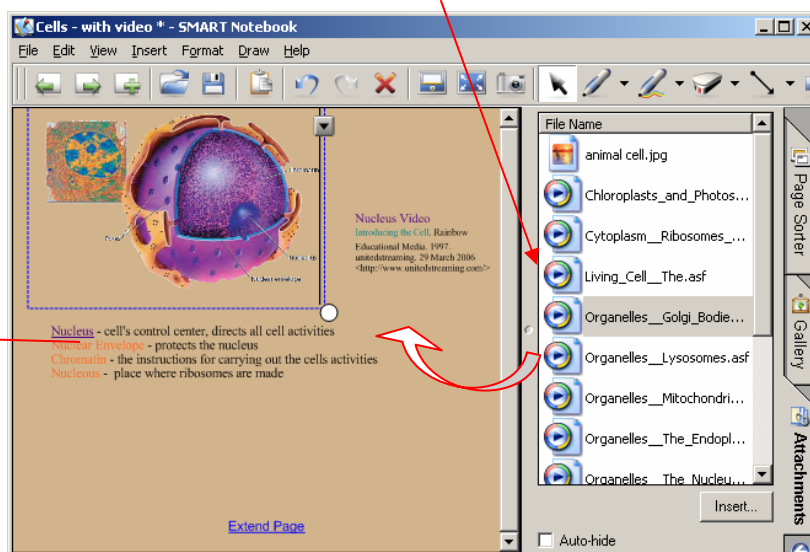

3. Open SMART Notebook software to create new project or open an existing project. All video(s) for this project must be in the “Attachments” section.

Click, hold, and drag downloaded videos and images into the “Attachments” section of Notebook.

4. From the Attachment section, click and hold on the video you want to insert then drag it on to the page. The hyperlink will automatically be created by Notebook.



You can add additional text such as directions and the video citation.

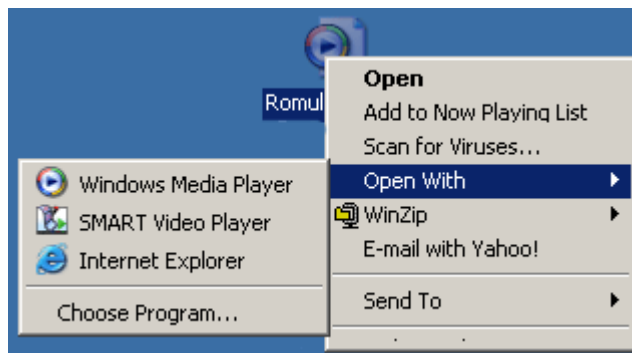
5. Be sure that you've selected SMART Video Player to view videos so you can take advantage of interactivity of the SMART board.



Changing Video Player Profile to use SMART Video Player

When playing unitedstreaming video(s) on a SMART board, it is important to view videos through the SMART Video Player. The SMART video player is standard with 9.3 and 9.5 and will allow users to take advantage of the interactive whiteboard and to prevent the video player from “taking over” the screen/computer. You will need to change the “Opens With” selection on your computer.

1. Download a video from unitedstreaming.
2. Right click on the video name and chose “Open With”
3. If SMART Video Player is not one of the choices, then select “Choose Program”.



4. You can either select SMART Video Player from the list or you might have to browse to your Programs section, Open the SMART folder, then select Video Player by clicking on it.
5. When done, click on OK.
